Riders information "Vielseitigkeitsmeeting 2021"

we're pleased to welcome you to our competition 2021. Unfortunately, we have to take into account certain restrictions due to covid-19 and equine herpes virus pandemic, which you're kindly asked to adhere to. The "Corona-Verordnung "of the federal state Lower Saxony is binding in this regard.

06. - 08. August 202

Following rules and guidelines do apply to our event:

- All attendees and escorts with German nationality have to present their certificate of a negative corona test (either PCR-test or rapid-test) not older than 24h; foreign riders and escorts have to present the certificate of a negative PCR-test, not older than 24h.
- For persons which are recovered with official letter as well as persons, which are vaccinated (completely vaccinated with two weeks waiting period after final vaccination), the rule for the tests do not apply; vaccination status have to be proven either by vaccination card or by a corresponding smartphone application.
- 2 escorts are allowed per attendee.
- Each person has to bring a completely filled attendance record (available via www.rechenstelle.de
 Per attendance record a wristband will be handed out. This wristband has to be carried during the whole event and to be shown upon request. A participation without this wristband is not allowed.
- The access to the event-area, including stables, with the known covid-19 symptoms is **prohibited**. When any symptoms do occur during the event, the corresponding person has to get in touch with the duty hygiene officer Mr. Georg Hohmann (+49160 5835030) and the doctor.
- You have to cover your nose and mouth with a mask (medical or FFP2-standard) in the stables and generally when a minimum distance of 1,5m to another person cannot be met.
- Disinfectant is available and has to be used on a regular basis.
- Riders do not have to wear a mask when riding.
- Everyone has to stick to the rule of 1,5m distance to other persons all the time.
- Horse pass will be handed over when returning the back number.

With accessing the event area and the stud farm, one is accepting the rules and guidelines issued by the event organiser.

A non-compliance is also a violation according to the LPO § 920, 2.k. and regulatory measures would have to be applied according to LPO § 921. Moreover, offences could be punished with regulatory fees.

Unloading the horses is not allowed prior the accreditation!!!

Following documents will have to be presented in printed form:

- corona test certificate or proof of vaccination or rather proof of recovery
- identity document
- attendance record
- horse pass/FEI-Pass
- FEI Equine Health-Self Certification Form and Temperature Record Sheet (bring your own thermometer)

Once successfully accredited, you will get your horse stable.

Attendees with horses not having a horse stable provided by the event organiser and participating on international tests, do have to present their documents at the office. Unloading of horses is not allowed without having the permission from the FEI-veterinarian.

The attendees of the Geländereiter-WBs have to bring their corona test certificate or proof of vaccination or rather proof of recovery, identity document and attendance record the office.
